Since the last update in November, construction crews have finalized the underground utility work, including the installation of a domestic water line. Demolition of the 4-H building started in December, and cleanup will continue throughout January. This site, located on the corner of Hall of Fame and Monroe avenues, will serve as the construction headquarters for the New Frontiers project.

The next bidding phase is underway, and we are looking forward to making additional progress on our state-of-the-art teaching, research and Extension facility. Soon, we will see the construction crane go up, and its footprint will be located in what will be the courtyard of the new building.

In addition, Jan. 15 marked the two-year anniversary of the <u>historic gift announcement</u> by Kayleen and Larry Ferguson that renamed the College and launched the New Frontiers public campaign. We are reminded of the excitement of that day, and we continue to be grateful for the Fergusons and their vision to feed the world through OSU Agriculture.
