In other exciting news, the construction site is booming with activity! Since our last update, construction crews drilled almost 200 piers that extend down 50 feet to support the building. They also installed the base of the tower crane with 150 tons of concrete to support the crane, which arrived on July 12 in several pieces. One of the largest cranes to be used in the Stillwater area, the crane was fully erected in a day and stands 143 feet tall and is 265 feet long.
