NEW FRONTIERS UPDATE June 2024

Summer is in full swing and so is the progress on our new home. Reaching "substantial" completion on June 3 allowed us to move equipment into the new building. We started with the computer labs, followed by the teaching laboratories. Our construction partners are rapidly working toward "final" completion, scheduled for July 29, when we can start occupying the building with people.

As we anticipate the facility's completion later this summer, I want to share with you the news about the naming of our new building. On June 14, the OSU/A&M Board of Regents voted to name the new building Agricultural Hall and rename the original Ag Hall to Legacy Hall.

I am pleased with this decision. The naming signifies the history and legacy of Agricultural Hall and allows it to continue for future generations of Cowboys. New Frontiers will always embody

As with any change, there will be a transition period. We are targeting August 1 for the current Ag Hall to officially change to Legacy Hall.

It's an exciting era for OSU Agriculture. I'm glad you're part of it.






