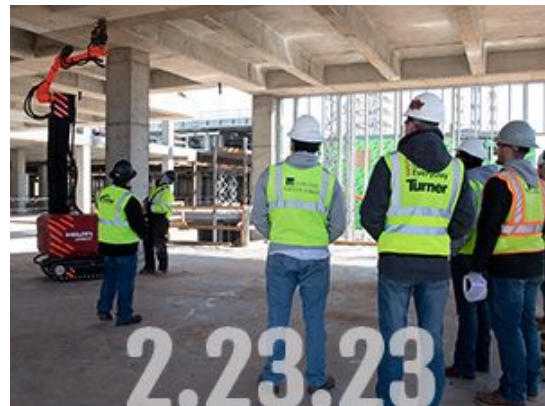

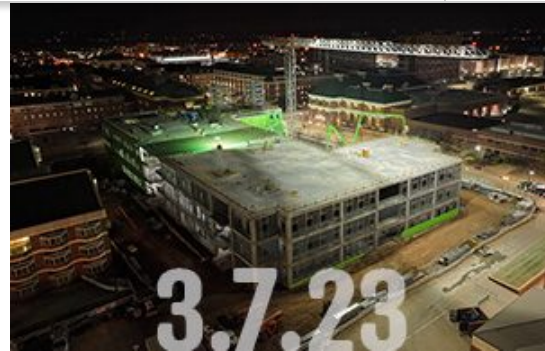
With the middle section of the building now constructed and the final concrete pour completed, we now have full access to walk from one side of the building to the other. On the south end of the building, framing of the third-floor laboratory areas is mostly complete with chimney framing in progress. In addition, construction workers are framing out windows and applying sheathing on the north end. Currently, 10% of windows have been installed in the building, and window inspections will be conducted to test water penetrations. Upcoming this month is the installation of the signed beam in the facility. Look for additional information as we celebrate the significance of this activity.

Our fundraising efforts continue even though we reached the \$50 million fundraising goal. We have various naming opportunities available, including building features that will only be possible through additional donor support.
