NEW FRONTIERS UPDATE **November 2022**

'Tis the season of gratitude. I want to thank our donors and supporters who have helped make the New Frontiers project a reality. I'm also proud of our students as they wind down the semester, and I'm grateful for the dedication of our faculty and staff statewide. In less than two years, our state-of-the-art facility will be open, and by the end of fall 2024, our faculty, staff and students will have completed their first semester in the new building.

The construction process has been exciting to watch. Our partners have poured the entire concrete foundation for the first floor and are building the remaining second and third floors in sections. They started with the more complicated infrastructure in the research labs on the south side of the building and are nearing completion of this area. Once finished, they will remove all support members that were placed to allow the concrete to dry and framing of exterior walls will commence. Currently, they are setting forms to pour the second-floor concrete on the north side of the building and will continue upward to the third floor during the next few weeks. Please let us know if you're interested in a hardhat tour to see the progress firsthand.

Although we have reached the \$50 million fundraising goal in record time, we still have naming opportunities available to further enhance our teaching, research and Extension efforts. I look forward to keeping you informed through this newsletter and other communications.


